***Note on Terminology:** The words “sasquatch” and “bigfoot” are interchangeable. Generally speaking, “sasquatch” is the Canadian name for the creature and “bigfoot” is the American name. Wherever appropriate, I have used the term “sasquatch.” Further, I have chosen not to capitalize either word, although I have left them capitalized in quoted or reprinted material. I have also chosen to consider the word “sasquatch” and “bigfoot” as both singular and plural terms to avoid the cumbersome or inappropriate terms “sasquatches,” “bigfoots,” or “bigfeet.”*
