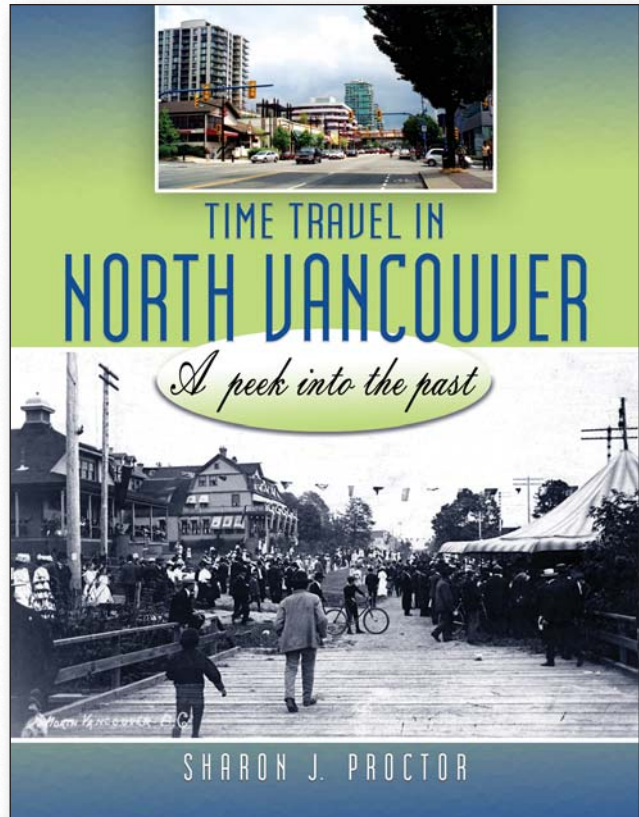

Or, stand in a quiet residential neighbourhood and picture the large, noisy lumber mill that once stood there. Find "ghosts" of the past that survive today.

Take a peek at the past through time's window and gain a new view, understanding and appreciation of this eclectic and vibrant community.
